



he Ladies Pairs Championship is open to all National Ladies Pairs and also to the Lady players whose standard of bridge is well known in their own country. Those pairs wishing to

participate in this International and very prestigious Tournament should apply to their Federations. We know that each country has a number of Ladies Pairs, not

selected to play internationally but who, nevertheless, have the necessary expertise to participate in this event, and we want to give all of them the opportunity to compete in this great Championship.

The European Ladies Pairs
Championship will be held in conjunction with the European Teams Championship in Malta, starting on Sunday 13 June 1999 at the same time as the Open Teams and ending on Tuesday 15 June before the start of the Ladies Teams
Championship. It will be played at the Hotel San Gorg, a lovely venue, which is where the Ladies Teams

Championship is to be played.

Malta 13-15 June 1999 Although only about 15 minutes gentle walk from the busy restaurant, bar, Casino and night-spot areas of Paceville and St. Julians. the main venue is located at the peaceful bay point by the waters edge.

In mid June the weather will be a warm but dry heat, probably about 27°C - 33°C mid-day, normally cooling to a pleasant 21°C at night. Of course, these super modern hotels are air-conditioned throughout. Even at the five star hotels. dress is informal although smartly casual in the evenings, jackets and ties are NOT required throughout, not even for the 'Opening' and 'Prize Giving' ceremonies. However, for those who may wish to go to the Casino, a jacket must be worn. Maybe a light cardigan may be useful by the water's edge at night.

Also, when not at the bridge table and if not in a sightseeing mood, a multitude of outdoors activities is available. These include tennis. diving, sailing and other water sports and golf at the 18 hole Royal Malta Golf Club (transportation to the golf course for guests from the three main hotels is free).

Because it is so small, 30x15 kms. it will be easy for Pairs 'sitting out'

to explore. Those who are less adventurous can relax by the pool or enjoy a swim in the clear warm. about 23°C. Mediterranean Sea

This event will be a wonderful opportunity to participate in a high-level Bridge Championship, such as you may have dreamed of. You could perhaps organise a holiday at the same time, bringing your family or friends with you. We have available some excellent suggestions which we feel sure will be of great

interest to you and your family.

The Opening Ceremony, hosted by the NTOM, will be held in the magnificent

he main complex comprises of 3 hotels, the Radisson SAS, the San Gorg Corinthia and the Marina Corinthia. The Open and the Vugraph will probably be located at the Radisson, and the Ladies Teams and

Pairs and the Senior Teams will be at the San Gorg (the EBL reserve the right to switch the playing venues. from the *San Gorg* and 4 minutes from the *Radisson*. All three hotels are very modern and comfortable with direct sea frontage. Special group rates have been obtained by the EBL for all participants and the Press.

Special reduced rates have also been obtained from several other hotels within a 10-15 minutes walk from the playing venues. Hotels beyond those suggested are not really recommended as the weather will be hot and taxis are expensive. Also, traffic can be very heavy.



The cruise begins from Sliema
Ferries, with spectacular views of
Valletta and its Bastions from
Marsamxett Harbour. The boat then
proceeds to the Grand Harbour and
will view 'The Three Cities' of
Senglea, Vittoriosa and Cospicua.
The cruise also passes through the
dockyard, where super-tankers and
cruise liners are repaired. A guide on
board the boat will give full commentary throughout. We will then
proceed to the Malta Crafts Village
at Ta' Qali where those who wish
will have time to shop!



Malta 13-15 June 1999 Valletta is the 16th century capital city of Malta and this tour begins with a walk around the Upper Barracca Gardens for a panoramic view of the Grand Harbour. Then we proceed to St John's Co-Cathedral, and finally to the Grand Master's Palace which houses the Maltese Parliament, the offices of the President of Malta, the 'State' Rooms, Tapestry Chamber and the Armoury.

We then go by coach to the silent city of *Medina*, formerly the capital of Malta, with its bastions which date back to the 9th century and offer a panoramic view of the whole island.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE COURSES

Many of you may feel that you are missing out by not being able to speak English very well. Malta is very well known as an excellent centre for teaching English to foreigners. One of the better established schools, which is only about 15 minutes walk from the main venue hotels, is called the Elanguest Language School. A one week course here costs just Lm45 (about \$120). This course, for example, has 4 lessons each morning starting at 8.45 and finishes at about noon, leaving the rest of the day free for other leisure activities; but there are many other different courses, some of which are more intensive, whilst others are just for English con-

versation. You can profit from improving your English during your stay, as could your children. So, do give it some thought!

Format

The Championship will consist of three qualifying rounds and two final rounds; **bidding boxes** will be used throughout and the final will be played with **screens**. There will be a carry-forward score for pairs qualifying for the final.

Entry Fees

The entry fee for this prestigious Championship will be 280 Swiss Francs per pair.

The method of payment will be advised to NCBOs by the Treasurer in due course.

Entries

Each NCBO will be required to send its final entry for the Ladies Pairs by 20 May 1999, although late entries may be accepted at the Championship venue provided there is sufficient space. All players wishing to participate in this event must, therefore, inform their NCBO in good time so that nominations can be sent to the EBL Credentials Committee in accordance with the conditions of entry. As is usual for European Championships, participation is by invitation of the EBL.

Prizes

Money prizes will be given to the winning pairs: to the first 10 in the Final and to the first 5 in the Consolation event

Beautiful prizes offered by the Malta Bridge Federation and other sponsors will also be given to pairs in both the Final and Consolation events.

Master Points

European Master Points will be awarded on the usual Championship scale.

Delegates' Meeting

There will be a Meeting for the Ladies Delegates during the course of the Championship.

Great care is being taken by the Ladies Committee to present a tournament of high quality. You will be able to experience the exciting atmosphere of the GENERALI European Teams Championship, to play in a very prestigious international competition and, at the same time, to enjoy the scenery in one of the most beautiful parts of Europe.
